Having this facility for parents to bring their children to will support them indirectly, as they will have an opportunity to bring their children to a place to run around safely, learn new skills and keep active. 2. This will give opportunity for new friendships to be formed. 3. Loneliness is a great concern within our communities – 7.1% of people in Great Britain experience chronic loneliness and in 2022 a study showed 49.63% of adults (25.99 million people) in the UK reported feeling lonely occasionally, sometimes, often or always (https://www.campaigntoendloneliness.org/facts-and-statistics/) Having a track available for members of the community to use will allow people to connect with others. 4. Sport enables lifelong friendships and fosters a deep connection with people, particularly for those living on their own. 5. Family and carers will use this track to further connect with their family, having a fun and accessible activity that they can use throughout the year in all weathers. 6. This is an opportunity for volunteers to support something they are passionate about, e.g. a volunteer can begin an athletics club or child's running club. 7. Having the track will enable the school to start a Bledlow Ridge adults running club, open to all of the community in Bledlow and the surrounding areas.
